





 CHARGE NUMBER ONE:

On Wednesday, 31 October, 2001 at approximately 12:20 p.m. the accused before the courts, Bruce McARTHUR, attended 484 Church Street, apt. 114, in the City of Toronto.

The accused was invited into the residence of the vicitm, as the parties are casual acquaintances. The victim turned away and was struck to rear of the head with a metal pipe. The victim was struck several times to head and body, and hands and arms as he attempted to defend himself against the assault.

The accused brought to the metal pipe with him to the residence of the victim. The assault was unprovoked.

The accused fled the scene the assault. The accused subsequently attend at Police Headquarters, located at 40 College Street, advising a police officer he had been involved in something. The accused was investigated by officers responding to an assault complaint.

The accused was arrested, advised of his rights and transported to 52 Division for further investigation.

The victim was transported to St. Mike's Hospital for emergency treatment of his injuries.

extremely cooperative, and I have a very, very nervous complainant, who very much wishes to avoid testifying. I've explained, Your Honour, that Mr. McArthur is going to acknowledge that on the facts he is guilty of assault with a weapon and assault cause bodily harm. He is acknowledging that he has no explanation for what caused the incident. My

friend is going to be having him assessed at the North York General Hospital, Branson Division, through an outpatient court support program. There is some suggestion that his client, who has a history of mental health related issues, not on the night in question, of severe depression, as I understand it, that he has suffered from severe depression. He may allege that he had taken poppers and had been on dilantin for a -- a lifetime history dealing with epilepsy and seizures. And I believe that's why he was taking the dilantin.

The only stumbling block, Your Honour, in all of this, is the context. The complainant in this matter is prepared to acknowledge without testifying that, and he has told me that I can put this clearly on the record, that the complainant in this matter is -- had from time to time advertised in a gay newspaper and other publications as a male hustler. I think that's the generic term, that -- but that the ads would be clear that it was sex for money situations. He insists that, what he recalls, is the most that he ever advertises is \$80.00 for an hour. That -- the facts where we're in agreement are -- is on the night in question; he foolishly let the accused in through the back door of the apartment that he, the complainant, lived in. He is willing to acknowledge that he knew

the complainant to see. He is willing to acknowledge that by letting him in through the back door, and knowing that he wasn't supposed to let anyone in through the back door, and acknowledging his general reputation on the male hustling side of things, that it may have been that Mr. McArthur believed that there was an opportunity for sex. But there's a categorical denial of sex, and he is not --Mr. McArthur (sic) blacks out, and he's not alleging that there was any sex.




















On November 8th, blood from the back of the van is Identified as belonging to Andrew Kinsman

53 Mallory Crescent, 227 Conlins Road, and 2598 Cooper Road (Madoc) had been identified through surveillance of McArthur








