The Investigative Genetic Genealogy Accreditation Board (IGGAB) takes public trust seriously, which is why we have codified in our IGG Standards that IGG practitioners may only upload forensic DNA profiles to sites that give their users the choice whether to participate in IGG matching. Any IGG practitioner who wishes to be credentialed by IGGAB must agree to this provision, and credentialed IGG practitioners who violate this provision will be subject to sanction.
